Using ProQuest

ProQuest database coverage includes: major academic sources, AltPress Watch, Ethnic Newswatch, ABI-Inform business info, and National Newspapers. E-Library includes: photos, audiovisuals, books, magazines, NPR and other transcripts.

Log-on Procedure:

1. From the AUS Library homepage, <http://www.antiochsea.edu/lib/index.html>, click the ProQuest button.
2. If you are on campus, begin searching. If you are off campus you will need to log-in. **Contact the library for login and password.**
3. Click “ProQuest Online” button on the bottom left side of screen:



Search Types:



Use this for one-word searches and *broad topics*.



Do a *very precise search* using many keywords, authors, etc.



Search for a *particular journal* by its title.

Search Options:

1. Full text articles only : Only results that give you the *full text* of the article for printing
2. Scholarly journals, including peer-reviewed: Only *academic articles* that went through an *editorial process with specialists in the field*.
